



The fastest way to post is to use the QuickPress (what you see there below on the right). It won't add any bells and whistles but it will get the info where it needs to be asap.

If you want to go the long way that gives you a few more options, roll your mouse over "Posts" and then click on "Add New". You should see something similar to the QuickPress but with more things you can do with it. Since this is a basic (re: free!) wordpress.com account, you won't get to choose certain things like different fonts or background color but you can use Bold, Italic, Underline, change the text color, etc.
